



FAQs - Pre-school Hours and Costs

Pre-school hours 8.55 to 11.55 – morning session – 5 x 3hr sessions
 12.30 – 3.30 – afternoon session – 5 x 3hr sessions

How are Pre-schools funded?

The City of York Council fund 5 x 3hrs (15 hrs.) per week for every child aged 3 and over.

Can I request additional hours?

There is also an additional 15hrs funding for working families (making 30hrs in total), the Council will issue a voucher for families who are eligible for the additional hrs. Families have to deal direct with the Council to apply for the voucher, this application can be made during the half term prior to their child commencing in Pre-school. The School Bursar requires a copy of the voucher.

Parents who are not eligible for the 30hrs can purchase further sessions at £12 per session (3hr session).

When can my child start Pre-school?

Pupils can be admitted to Pre-school the term following their 3rd birthday.

Osaldwick Primary takes admission for Pre-school in September, January and April each year.

Are there any additional costs?

The cost for a pupil staying for a full day:

Lunch time supervision	3.50
Hot dinner	<u>2.25</u>
Total	<u>£5.75 per day</u>

How and when do I pay for these costs?

The cost of hot dinners should be paid in to the school office on a weekly basis at the beginning of the week, in addition the lunch time supervision cost will be invoiced at the beginning of the term by the Bursar. Children may bring a packed lunch if they wish, leaving just the cost of lunch time supervision.
