(Please do not think, however, that because it takes place in The Minster School the repertoire or standard is chorister based!) The choir, plus the schools' singing project, is partly paid for by the York Minster and the Minster School so there is no cost to join. There is also no audition process to the join the choir. The choir has performed at many concerts, including in York Minster and the Barbican.
