Dear Parents/Carers

I hope that you are all well. Please see below for information about drop off and collection from Sports Club and Holiday Club.

Sports Club

Sessions will run from 8am-1pm.

Children will need to bring:

- Pack up and a water bottle. There will be no facility to top up water bottle so if it is hot, please ensure they have enough to last for the full session.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather. If it rains, there will be some time spent indoors but it is likely that they will still be outdoors for a period of time. If necessary, please send in some spare kit that they could change into if they get wet.

Drop Off and Pick Up from Sports Club

There will be a 1 way system in operation to ensure safe distancing of everyone on site. This is in accordance with our Risk Assessment. Please take the path to the left hand side of the main doors, around the side of the building and into the playground at the back. Mr Scoreby will be waiting at the MUGA to meet and greet and register the children.

Please then continue across the playground and exit via the gate next to the Year 1 classroom. From there, follow the path back to the front of the school and exit the school site. There is signage that will show you the way.

Gates will be opened just before 8am and closed again at 8.15am. If you arrive later than 8.15am there will be no admission. Gates need to be closed for the safeguarding of all children on site. Gates will be open just before 1pm for collection. Please be prompt to collect as the gates can then be closed again and the site made secure.

Holiday Club

Sessions will run from 8am-6pm.

Children will need to bring:


- Pack up and a water bottle. There will be no facility to top up water bottles so if it is hot, please ensure they have enough to last for the full session.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather - some activities will still take place outdoors even if there is light rain.

Drop Off and Pick Up from Holiday Club

Access to and from Holiday Club will be via the blue doors at the front of the building. Please ring the bell and wait for staff to answer and register the children. . We would ask that you safely maintain distance when dropping off and collecting in accordance with our Risk Assessment and do not enter the building.
