



## Early Years - Remote Teaching and Learning Guidance What Will Remote Teaching and Learning Look Like for My Child/ren?

In Early Years we use the Tapestry app for sharing activities for home learning.



In Reception, your child's activities will be posted onto Tapestry at 9am.

This will be a Phonics, Maths and Handwriting activity each day. There will also be a story read by a member of the Reception Team, usually linked to the Topic/Creative Curriculum and this will include ideas for parents and carers to discuss with the child to extend their learning.

In Early Years, the children learn through play and a play activity will also be posted twice a week. Please spend time daily playing with your child, talking with them and joining in with their games.

Please post photos and/or videos of your child taking part in both home learning activities set by school and also anything else they are doing indoors and out and about!

Each learning activity will include instructions from the teacher either via a video, voice instructions or written instructions.

Parents and carers can respond on behalf of the child by either typing a response of taking a picture or video or voice recording.

The children **must** complete all of the taks set on Tapestry and submit their responses through comments, photos, videos or voice messages. Once the responses have been submitted, staff will provide feedback on the learning and activities completed and maybe a next step to challenge the learning further.

Each morning, please check Tapestry and complete each day's learning activities at a time that suits you. If you need support with any of the activities or need to ask questions, messages can be sent to staff and they will respond as soon as they can.

There is also a list of websites that have been shared with parents and carers via Tapestry and in the Home Learning Pack.

Home Learning Packs will be available for individual children who need to self isolate and will include reading, writing, handwriting, maths and phonics activities and are designed to be completed with some independence.
