



Key Stage 1 Remote Teaching and Learning Guidance What Will Remote Teaching and Learning Look Like for My Child/ren?

In KS1, your child's activities will be posted on See Saw at 9am.



Each day there will be a "Good Morning" video from their class teacher, checking in and explaining the activities for that day. There will also be a daily Maths and Phonics lesson with a recorded lesson from the teacher with teaching and explanations for the tasks set. It is an expectation that children will complete their daily Phonics and Maths activity.

Tasks set for Literacy, Topic/Creative Curriculum and Well Being activities will be shared at the beginning of each week. There will be a number of activities for these subjects and children are to choose a minimum of 3 to complete over the course of the week. In the morning video, teachers will share which Literacy and Topic/Creative Curriculum activity will be being done in school that day and encourage children at home to join in with the same one. Information and instructions will be shared on the slides with links to resources, stories and activities provided if needed. Instruction on how to complete the activity will be provided by the teachers on the slides either in writing or via voice message.

Well Being activities are also shared at the beginning of the week. These are short activities focusing on healthy minds and bodies and children are encouraged to complete them over the course of the week.

Once children have submitted their completed activities, staff will provide feedback on their learning and maybe a next step to challenge the learning further. This will be in the form of comments, videos or voice recordings.

Government Guidance states that KS1 children should complete 3 hours of learning each day but we recommend regular breaks for the children and yourselves!
