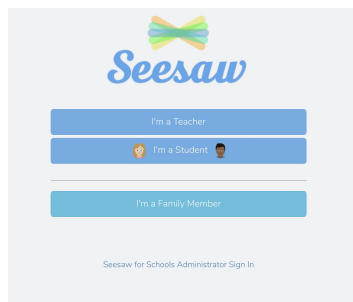




Key Stage 2 Remote Teaching and Learning Guidance What Will Remote Teaching and Learning Look Like for My Child/ren?

In KS2, the See Saw app and Google Classroom are used to post and upload work.



Work will be posted from 9am onto Google Classroom. Government Guidance states that KS2 children will complete 4 hours of learning each day.

Each day there will be a “Good Morning” video from their class teacher, checking in and explaining the activities for that day.

The timetable for KS2 is:

Maths - 9-10am

Guided Reading - 10-11am

Writing - 11.15am-12.15pm

Topic/Creative Curriculum - 1.30pm-2:30pm

Check back time - 2:30-3:15pm

It is expected that children complete each task for each lesson each day.

Each lesson will begin with an instructional video by the class teacher explaining content and concepts to be taught and learnt during that lesson. Work will be set on Google Slides and can be edited by children during the lesson. When they have completed their work, children are asked to submit it to the classroom teams for feedback. If, during a lesson, a child is in need of support, they are able to message into their class and a member of the classroom team will offer support remotely.

Once children have submitted their completed activities, staff will provide feedback on their learning and maybe a next step to challenge the learning further. This will be in the form of comments, videos or voice recordings or using the Green/Pink marking code. Children are invited to return to check their work and complete any “Pinks” (misconceptions and challenges) from 2.30-3.15pm each day.

A weekly timetable for KS2 would look like this:
