Following the announcement by the Prime Minister this evening, school will not be opening for the foreseeable future, but will switch to online learning.

Frontline School - Tuesday January 5th

We will be operating our Frontline School provision **only** for the children who accessed Frontline School during the previous lockdown. An email will be sent to the parents and carers of these children following this letter. These are children of Key Workers and our most vulnerable children.

Tomorrow the list of eligible children will be reviewed and I will be sending out a Google Form to **all** parents with details of how to access Frontline School if you think you may be eligible.

Engagement levels will be monitored and, of course, teachers and teaching assistants will be available remotely to provide the usual encouragement and support. Our Well being check ins will also resume from next week.

Please bear with us all as we react to this fast moving situation. Please look out for the Google Form regarding Frontline School tomorrow and return it if you think your child is eligible for the provision. I will continue to stay in touch with you all throughout the coming days.
