
Listening Event

Thomas Emmett is Head of Education, Senior Associate Solicitor at Birkett Long LLP and will answer questions on SEND law on topics such as:

- EHCPs and The EHC needs assessment process
- Requesting an EHC needs assessment
- Refusal to assess appeals at the SEND Tribunal
- Refusal to issue appeals at the SEND Tribunal
- Appealing the contents of an EHCP at the SEND Tribunal (including school placement)
- Appealing a decision to cease to maintain an EHCP at the SEND Tribunal
- Appealing a decision to refuse to re-assess at the SEND Tribunal **Judicial review**
- Disability discrimination
- School transport matters
